Trophies for best individual player under-18 on 31 August 2019, best individual player under-11 on 31 August 2019. Medals for players placed 2nd and 3rd.

The congress is organised by Dr Ray Collett for Worcestershire Junior Chess Academy and Worcestershire Chess Association. King's School Worcester supports junior chess in Worcestershire by offering free use of its facilities for this event.



Each junior school entrant will receive a mascot. All children will have five games, unless there is an uneven number of entrants, when one player each round will receive a full point bye. There will be trophies for winners and medals for other high scoring players.

It is likely that entrants will span a wide range of ages, but in the first round players of similar age will play together. In other rounds, players will be paired with opponents with the same score as far as possible.
